PARK ROAD DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS**

**NOTICE OF STUDY COMPLETION**

The Town of Innisfil have completed a Schedule 'B' Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA Study) for drainage improvements to Park Road. The study was carried out following the requirements for and in accordance with Schedule B projects under the Municipal Class EA process.

**Project Background**

The primary objective of the Municipal Class EA was to improve drainage and to alleviate flooding concerns on private properties along Park Road and improve drainage characteristics through the Project site. Specifically, the study will divert an existing ditch conveying flows from a large external area away from Park Road drainage system to a new channel within Innisfil Beach Park.



**The final Environmental Study Report (ESR) is being released for a 30-day public and agency review and comment period from July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021 to August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021.**

In addition, a Part II Order request may be made to the Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks for an order requiring a higher level of study (i.e., requiring an individual/comprehensive EA approval before being able to proceed), or that conditions be imposed (e.g., require further studies), only on the grounds that the requested order may prevent, mitigate, or remedy adverse impacts on constitutionally protected Aboriginal and treaty rights. Requests on other grounds will not be considered. Requests should include the requester contact information and full name for the ministry.

Requests should specify what kind of order is being requested (request for additional conditions or a request for an individual/ comprehensive environmental assessment), how an order may prevent, mitigate, or remedy those potential adverse impacts, and any information in support of the statements in the request. This will ensure that the ministry is able to efficiently begin reviewing the request.
